Committees

Fundraiser Committee - This committee is responsible for developing methods of generating funds to meet budget requirements and to foresee and prepare for growth and expansion. Fundraising efforts include obtaining grants, loans, corporate and individual sponsorships, contributions and in-kind donations, plans major fundraising events and membership drives. This committee will work closely with our pro bono law firm, A+B, LLP, to develop presentations for potential grants, private donors etc.

Public Relations Committee - This committee is responsible for publication of the newsletter, maintains open correspondence and communication with the membership and the public. Also responsible for advertising and “getting the word out” about all programs and events of WOV. Handles all Public Services Announcements, Press Releases and Member and Marketing materials.

What WOV Is Doing

Women of Virtue, Incorporated's primary goal is to foster unity among women, build a network of women who are working towards wisdom, understanding and empowerment in order to gain dominion, balance and stability in their lives. WOV seeks to nurture, develop and support nations of Virtuous Women who are healthy, wealthy, well-balanced and wise in every area of their lives. Empowering women to become leaders, influencing and impacting positive change in our families, businesses, communities, society in general and our WORLD.

Women of Virtue, Incorporated

- Has assisted several members to incorporate and start their own businesses, providing personal, business and financial coaching.
- Have counseled, coached and assisted financially or supportively several members through varying life events.

 - For many Americans the inability to afford comprehensive healthcare insurance or short-term disability insurance during a major medical experience creates a variety of hardships for families. Financial obligations are increased, while income is decreased, during these times of illness or crisis. Women of Virtue wishes to do its part in helping to alleviate some of that hardship by providing financial assistance. Women of Virtue will partner with local medical establishments, such as the Lombardi Cancer Institute, Howard University and other organizations such as human service departments, churches etc., and be a resource to those who may need some financial assistance during their recovery period. In 2004 we assisted 3 individuals.
 - **CRITERIA FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**
 - (1) Must submit a fully completed WOV Financial Assistance Request Application. With this application, official documentation of your illness/treatment (from your physician and/or service provider) and/or crisis (from a referral/written testimony and/or service provider).
 - (2) The financial assistance request can only be for groceries, household utility bills (can include auto or health insurance premiums), medical bills, prescriptions, childcare, and in extreme family crisis, for clothing.

- (3) The requested assistance amount will not exceed \$100 for one month. If approved to receive assistance consecutively for 2 months, the requested assistance amount will not exceed \$100 per month. You can only receive assistance for one assistance period (which comprises of 1 month or 2 months consecutively) per year.
- (4) After receipt of the request application and all required paperwork, the Financial Assistance Board will make a determination to approve or deny the request. If approved, the monies will be paid directly to the creditor or provider of service. If denied, a letter will be forwarded to the applicant with an explanation.
